

## **STUDENT BUS BEHAVIOUR CODE**

Students are expected to adhere to the Bus Behaviour Code. Let us work together to keep everyone safe and happy, on the journey to and from school. Parents are encouraged to discuss these following standards with their child at home.

## Do's:

- Wear a face mask at all times.
- Travel by your designated school bus.
- Be on time for pick up and departure.
- Make sure the road is safe before crossing the street.
- Stay at least 10 steps away from the school bus and make sure the Bus Driver can see you.
- Avoid the danger zone areas surrounding the bus.
- Cooperate with the Bus Guardian for temperature checks.
- Scan your RFID card when boarding and getting off the bus.
- Sit in the designated bus seat as advised by the Bus Guardian.
- Keep your seat belt on for the entire journey.
- Remain seated until advised by the Bus Guardian.
- Always face forward when seated.
- Keep the aisles and walkway clear at all times.
- Be courteous and follow the Bus Guardian and Bus Driver's instructions.
- If you feel unwell, immediately report to the Bus Guardian or Bus Driver.
- Use electronic devices responsibly and report any misuse to your Bus Guardian or Bus Driver.
- Take your personal items with you when you leave the bus.

## Don'ts:

- Stand while the school bus is moving.
- Sit on a restricted seat.
- Distract the Bus Driver.
- Shout or be disrespectful towards others.
- Bring friends onto the bus without written permission from STS and the school.
- Eat or drink (except water) on the bus.
- Throw objects of any kind in the bus.
- Place anything on the windows of the bus.
- Damage the bus in any way.
